Case Study: DXC


To ensure the future of DXC Technology's Digital Transformation Center, the State funded \$25 million in higher education initiatives focused on the number of degrees awarded in computer science, management, and STEM fields.

Case Study: Nunez/NASA

To develop key components of the NASA Orion crew capsule and Space Launch System which will send Americans to the moon and Mars, a qualified workforce is critical. In response, Louisiana launched a new Aerospace Manufacturing Center of Excellence at nearby Nunez Community College. The new curriculum built a direct workforce pipeline for Boeing and others working with NASA.

LED FastStart

The premier workforce development program in the United States, LED FastStart provides customized employee recruitment, screening, training development and training delivery for eligible new or expanding companies, all at no cost.



Higher Education

New Orleans is home to one of the highest concentrations of higher education institutions per capita in the nation with 13 universities and colleges including three HBCUs, three MBA programs, two medical schools, two law schools, and a premier pharmacy school.

Right-to-Work State

Louisiana is one of 28 states with Right-to-Work laws, with only 5.3% of the workforce participating in labor unions.




